

# Week 4: Blessing "Blessed to be a blessing""

1 Peter 2.9; Rev 1.5

Welcome to our series called "The Gospel" which means good news! Like a fine jewel, we have been cutting and polishing various facets of the gospel that reflect a different dimension of its message each week. So far we have looked at the individual and corporate facets followed by a deep dive into living out the Gospel in a culture that is increasingly hostile towards all things "Christian". We are in fact living in spiritual exile. Jeremiah the quintessential prophet of exile, encouraged us to not merely survive in exile, but to actually thrive in it as we seek and pray for the welfare of the city. This week we will learn how to do this specifically by blessing others around us

### 😔 SHARE & RECONNECT

- Share about the home you grew up in: was it an environment where words of blessing abounded or were they few and far between? Looking back, how do you feel about that stage of your life ?
- Share about a time when an individual, especially someone in authority over you, spoke or read words of blessing over you. What was the occasion? How did you feel?

- Read and compare Exodus 19. 5 with 1Peter 2.9. What strikes you?
- What does it mean, in terms of identity and practice for us to collectively to be a designated "a royal priesthood". What might change if we truly "saw " ourselves through the lens?

### REFLECT/WRITE

- If you heard the weekend message, what impacted you the most and why?
- What are the various obstacles that might get in the way of implementing the call to become priests for whom blessing people increasingly becomes a way of life?
- This weekends message had only one application: write a blessing. Spend the rest of your group time doing this. Here are a few guidelines:
  - Think of an individual or group (staff, elders, worship team, family, another Connect Group, etc) who you could bless.
  - Brainstorm significant things you know about the person/group (strengths, challenges, potential you can call out, etc).
  - Armed with this knowledge, brainstorm the content of your blessing asking for the Spirit's guidance. (Think of the various sources of material for blessing that the message mentioned: God's word, God's work, Images and metaphors. See some examples at the end of the guide.
  - Have different individuals in the group write one sentence. Share with each other, write a composite and wordsmith it as a group.
  - Send it (hand delivery, mail, or email).

- 1. For the the Spirit's help with the various obstacles you identified above in the journey towards becoming a royal priesthood.
- 2. Pray for the individual /group whom you chose to bless so they will indeed be blessed by the Lord..Remember Numbers 6.22-27—who does the blessing and who is the agent.
- 3. Using your experience in the "blessing exercise", pray for other Connect Groups and all those in the congregation who attempt to write their first blessing.





### BLESSING EXAMPLES:

# A blessing for high schoolers and university students based on Hebrews 11.23-27

I bless you with love of character over convenience or profit . May you like Moses not fear the kings anger as he left Egypt. So may you not fear loss of popularity or rejection. I bless you with influence that will lead others out of bondage and into real freedom. And may you make these four decisions that will determine your destiny because you will increasingly see Him who is invisible

With knowledge and depth of insight into the Scripture passages that you have been studying, with the wisdom to apply them to the lives of the people you teach so that they will immediately acknowledge the relevance of what you have taught, with diligence in studying and arranging your material so that it is logical and therefore illuminating to the listeners, with words that are beautiful through the appropriate use of metaphor, illustration and story that will imprint the principles indelibly on your listeners hearts, with words that are like goads and nails that provoke movement in the lives of your people without hurting them, with an economy of words so you will have the freedom to NOT share everything that is on your heart and with words that will refresh people who have come weary from their work.
